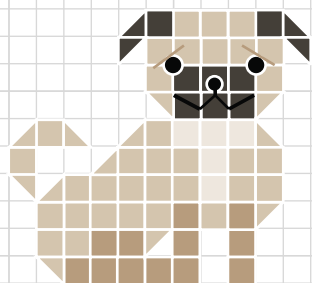
When stitching long-haired animals, stitch long, single back-stitches along the tail and sides of the body to give the effect of long or shaggy fur on the dog. Try mixing a few of these stitches throughout the body of the animal, too, in the same direction as the body is sitting!



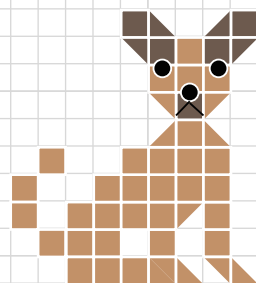
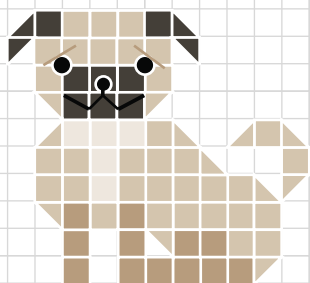
When stitching all-black animals, here are some ways you can make the black eyes and nose more visible: use dark gray floss, use dark brown floss, combine 1 white with 2 black floss threads, or use glittery/sparkle black floss for the French knots.
