## FLORAL SKIRT DESIGNS

## BY STITCH PEOPLE

## LEFT SKIRT:

Complete all cross-stitches of the skirt in black and dark green, as indicated. Then, combine 2 strands of light pink floss with 1 strand of dark pink floss, and complete some large, loose French knots, and some smaller, tighter French knots amonts the green cross-stitches to create the effect of flowers amongst their leaves.

## LEFT SKIRT:

Option 1 - Complete the entire skirt base in black or very dark green. Then, create a grid - or place at random - multiple French knots in the same colors as the flowers in the image.

Option 2 - Complete the cross stitches of the skirt in a random
 pattern of colors that correspond with the skirt fabric (3 strands of floss each).


## MIDDLE SKIRT

Complete the entire skirt in cross-stitches in a medium pink color. Atop the pink stitches, use 2 strands of maroon floss, blue floss, light pink floss and green floss, and mix and match diagonal stitches to create the look of smaller, streaky-looking flowers.

## RIGHT SKIRT:

Complete the entire skirt in cross-stitches using 2 strands of dark pink floss with 1 strand of light pink floss. To create the effect of lace along the edges of the skirt, complete cross stitches with 1 strand of dark pink floss atop the "legs" completed cross-stitches in the fleshcolored floss of the legs, and on the Aida fabric between the legs.

## RIGHT SKIRT:

Option 1 - Complete the cross stitches of the skirt in a random pattern of colors that correspond with the skirt fabric (3 strands of floss each). For the creamcolored background and to create the look of leaves, try combining 2 strands of cream colored floss with 1 strand green floss.

Option 2 - Complete cross stitches as shown in cream, light pink and dark pink (3 strands each). Atop the completed cross stitches, create French knots in yellow, and randomly placed diagonal stitches using 2-3 strands of green and blue floss.
