
STITCH PEOPLE


SHETLAND ("SHELTIE") DOG PATTERN

Match the colors of your Sheltie as closely as you can to the floss colors available to you, making changes to the pattern as needed to accommodate the correct colors. Don't be afraid to stitch outside the weave of the Aida fabric to achieve the look of an extra furry Sheltie! The wisps of fur around the chest are shown on the pattern in black for visibility but should match the fur color of your Sheltie's chest.

Use a large French knot to complete the nose, wrapping the thread around the needle 4 - 6 times, and/or stacking a series of looser French knots, one on top of the other.







Match the colors of your Chow Chow as closely as you can to the floss colors available to you, making changes to the pattern as needed to accommodate the correct colors. Don't be afraid to stitch outside the weave of the Aida fabric to achieve the look of an extra furry or extra wrinkly Chow Chow!

Combining threads from different floss colors will help to achieve a more natural look of fur, and using slightly-darker single thread of floss for the wrinkle definition will help to add character to the face.
